



Spetchley Park — Gardens —

Plants – Their Purpose and Potting Activity



Suitable for Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2

Following a quick question and answer session about the lifecycle of plants, students are then invited to pot their own plants to take a piece of Spetchley home with them. All equipment is supplied for the activity including gardening gloves and aprons.

Students can then add a Spetchley Flag with their name on to identify their own plant pot which can be taken home to their garden or a school garden plot.

The activity lasts 30 minutes and takes place in the Learning Centre.
